Whether you are a beginner like Maggie or a world-famous artist, please join us as we create and inspire together through community art.

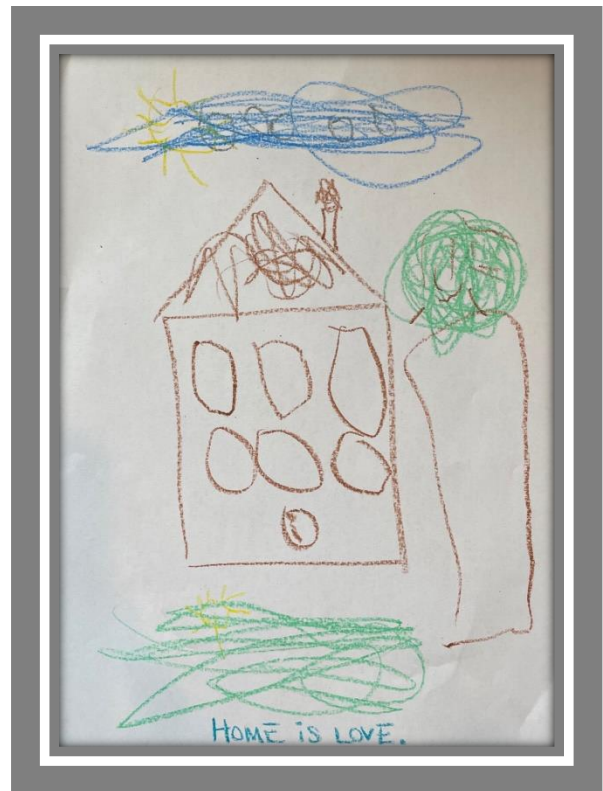
WHO: All ages are encouraged to participate.
